BOARD VACANCY

The Resort Village of Candle Lake Council is accepting applications to fill the vacancy for a member-at-large to sit on the North Central Lakeland District Planning Commission (NCLDPC). The NCLDPC is a Planning Commission made of representatives of the Resort Village of Candle Lake, the R.M. of Paddockwood, the District of Lakeland and the Village of Christopher Lake. The Board generally meets on a monthly basis in Paddockwood to review policies, plans and zoning bylaws that affect the municipalities within the planning district area. The NCLDPC is an advisory committee and provides recommendations to the Councils regarding policies and developments within the planning districts. The member-at-large will be paid an honourarium of \$100 per meeting and mileage for travel when applicable.

Candidates should demonstrate a duty for fairness, respect of the community, a keen interest and knowledge of the community, good analytical and reasoning skills, an appreciation for the interests of property owners, developers and the public, knowledge of local development processes and a willingness to donate your time to this board.
