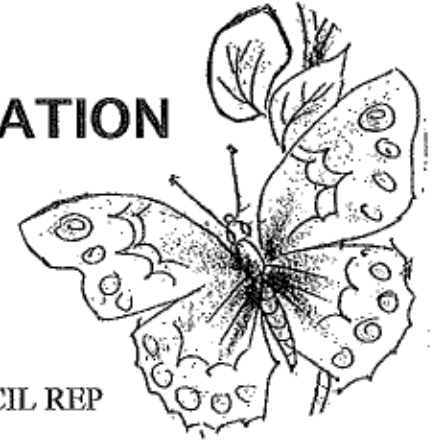

What is a Nurse Practitioner?

A RN(NP) is a Registered Nurse with advanced education and training to diagnose and manage common medical conditions, including chronic illnesses.

The NP maintains a close working relationship with a Physician. They can provide a broad range of health care services and provide much of the same care provided by a physician.

The NP can serve as a patient's regular health care provider, and see patients of all ages. NP's focus on patients' conditions, as well as the effects of illness on the lives of the patients and their families.

The services they offer include:

- Assessment, and management of common medical issues such as flu, colds, fevers, childhood diseases, rashes, sore throats, bladder infections, birth control, pregnancy testing, sexually transmitted diseases, mental health concerns, women's health concerns, wart removal.
- Manage and provide prescriptions for stable chronic conditions.
- Complete physical exams, including SGI medicals.
- Order tests and X-rays.
- Write new, or, reorder prescriptions.
- Lab services on site for blood work. Order x-rays or ultrasounds.
- Minor surgical procedures such as suturing.
- Syringe ears.
- Health promotion, illness and injury prevention.
- Work with you to help you manage your health and illnesses.

Multiple Sclerosis

Multiple sclerosis is a complex disease. While it is most often diagnosed in young adults, aged 15 to 40, we know that it affects children, some as young as two years old. The impact is felt by family, friends and by the community. MS is unpredictable, affecting vision, hearing, memory, balance and mobility. Its effects are physical, emotional, financial, and last a lifetime. There is no cure.

Did you know ...

- Canadians have one of the highest rates of multiple sclerosis in the world.
- MS is the most common neurological disease affecting young adults in Canada.
- Every day, three more people in Canada are diagnosed with MS.
- Women are more than three times as likely to develop MS as men.
- MS can cause loss of balance, impaired speech, extreme fatigue, double vision and paralysis.
- MS was first identified and described by a French neurologist, Dr. Jean-Martin Charcot, in 1868.
- We don't know what causes MS but researchers are closer to finding the answer.

Signs and symptoms of multiple sclerosis vary widely, depending on the location of affected nerve fibers. Multiple sclerosis signs and symptoms may include:

- Numbness or weakness in one or more limbs, which typically occurs on one side of the body at a time or the bottom half of the body
- Partial or complete loss of vision, usually in one eye at a time, often with pain during eye movement (optic neuritis)
- Double vision or blurring of vision
- Tingling or pain in parts of the body
- Electric-shock sensations that occur with certain head movements
- Tremor, lack of coordination or unsteady gait
- Fatigue
- Dizziness

Most people with multiple sclerosis, particularly in the beginning stages of the disease, experience relapses of symptoms, which are followed by periods of complete or partial remission. Signs and symptoms of multiple sclerosis often are triggered or worsened by an increase in body temperature.

In November 2009, Italian researcher Dr. Paolo Zamboni, made headlines worldwide with his study of CCSVI or chronic cerebro-spinal venous insufficiency. The MS community responded – with great hope, excitement and a call for immediate action. The MS Society shares this optimism and recognizes that this concept has already opened up new avenues of research and may lead to potential therapies.

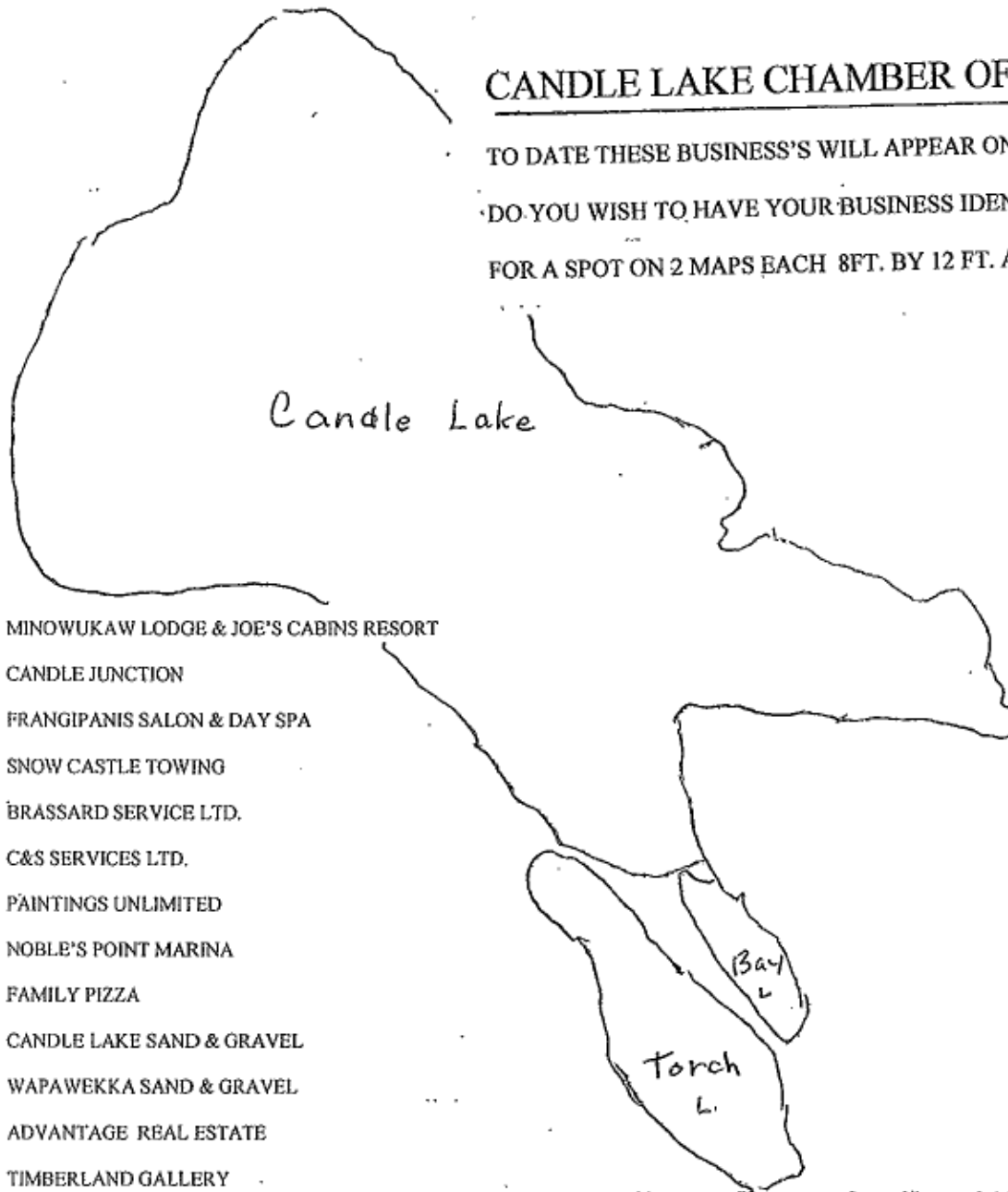
As with any new hypothesis, there are a number of questions still to be answered. To ensure we realize the full potential of any new discovery, early results need to be replicated and validated in multiple, large, and well-designed studies. While the pace of this process may seem frustratingly slow, it is critical to producing the very best answer for people living with MS around the world. Dr. Zamboni has opened a door for the community, and now we need to proceed with a balance of hopefulness and scientific rigour.

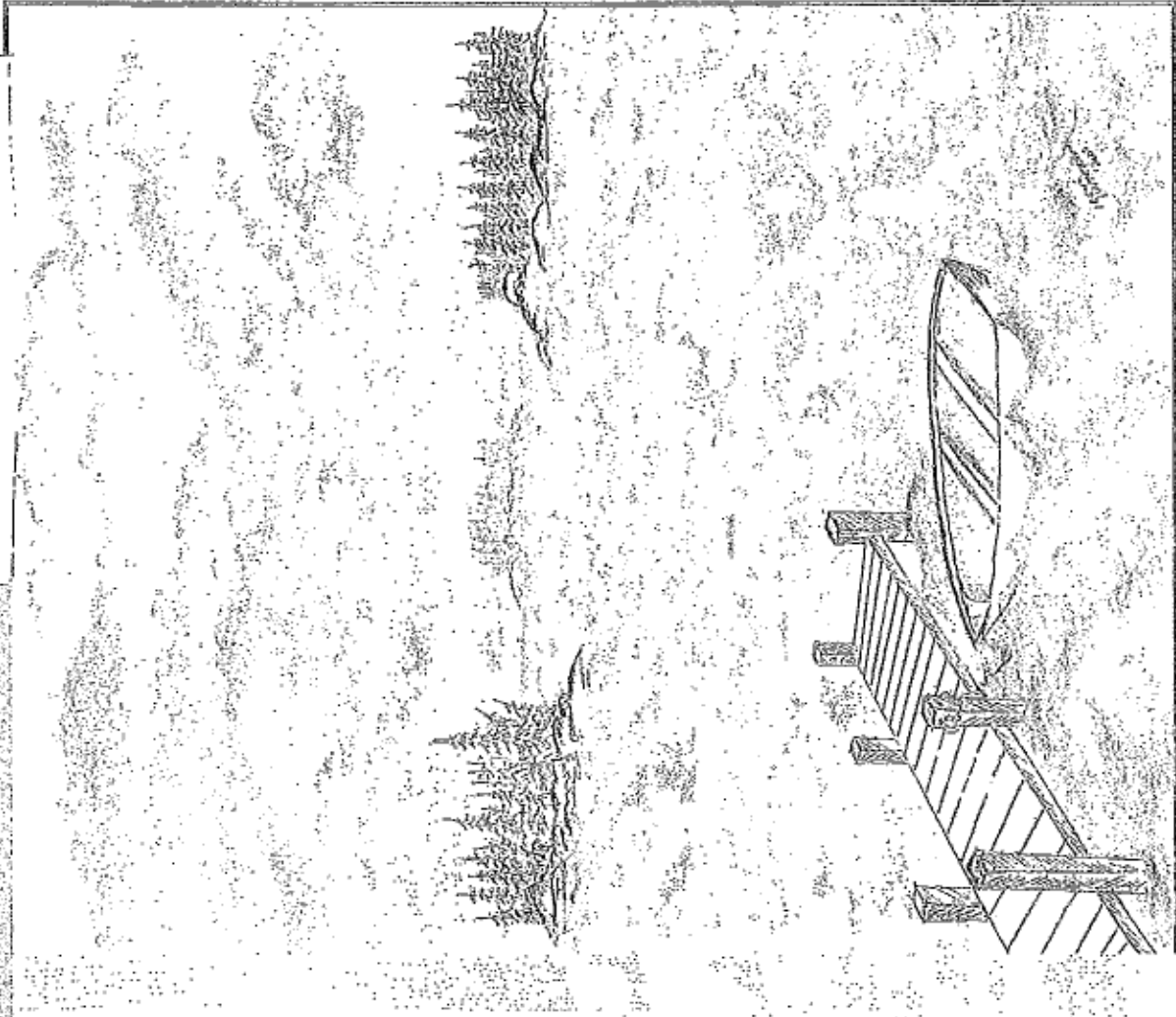
SEVERE STORMS

Things to do in a lightning storm

- Unplug radios, computers and televisions.
- If outdoors, take shelter in a building, ditch or a culvert – never under a tree.
- If in the open, do not lie flat. Crouch in the leap frog position and lower your head.
- Do not ride bicycles, motorcycles or golf carts.
- If swimming or in a boat, get back to shore.
- If you are in a car, stay there but pull away from trees which may fall.

Garbage for residential pick-up is to be packaged in large garbage bags and placed in secure containers. Containers should be placed at street side by 8:00 a.m. on the morning of pick-up.

Grass clippings and leaves are no longer being disposed of in the landfill pit and therefore are not being collected along with regular household garbage. Grass clippings and leaves can be disposed of at the landfill at no charge, providing there is no other type of refuse included with the bagged clippings and the clippings are removed from plastic bags and disposed of in the designated “compost” area.

The Resort Village has recently passed a bylaw limiting the use of the landfill to residents and property owners of the Resort Village of Candle Lake. Users may be required to provide evidence of residency or property ownership. Authorization for use of the landfill by non-resident/property owners is by signed agreement with the Resort Village, only. As well, authorization to access the Resort Village lagoons is now by permit only.

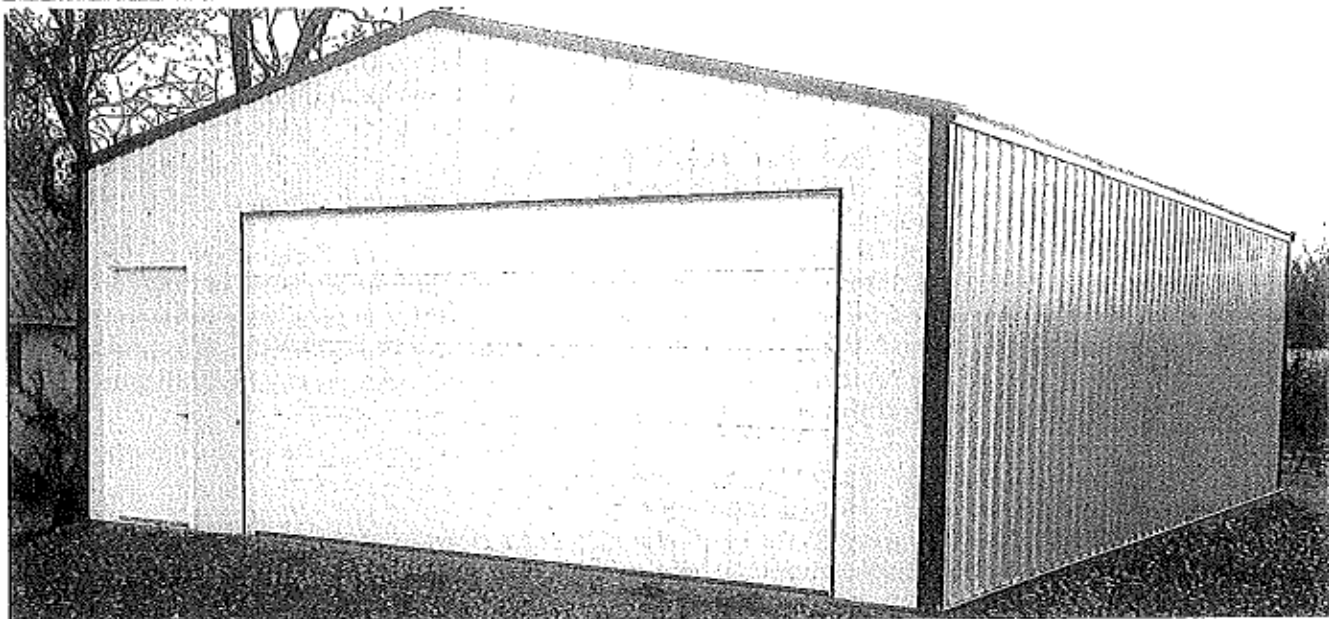

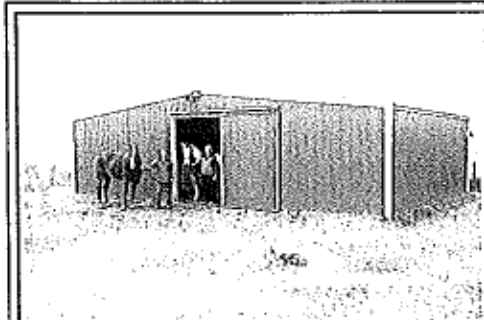

The Municipal Buffer is presently between the commercial property and Sunset Way, with the proposed re-zoning to residential, the present buffer will become part of the residential lots and a new municipal reserve will be dedicated-between the residential lots and the Highway.~~
